

# Harrison Central Band Booster Meeting

## Minutes from 10/05/2009

**Call To Order-** Belinda Stewart at 6:35 p.m.

### Business-

**Booster Meetings-** Our booster meetings are always held on the first Monday of the month at 6:30 p.m. We had 49 parents in attendance. There are 240 students in the band!

#### Football Game-

**Concession-** Thanks to all the parents that help, we need more volunteers! If you are working the concession during the game, please don't leave your post during half time. This is the busiest time of the night!

**Sideline Passes-** Passes must be returned to the Band Hall office after each game.

#### Competitions-

**Gulfport, October 10<sup>th</sup>**- School Bus- No Fee. Patches are available to order for \$5 each if the students would like one. They will be provided free of charge for all seniors.

**Perk, October 17<sup>th</sup>**- School Bus- No Fee

**Clinton, October 24<sup>th</sup>**- Charter Bus- \$60 Fee per Student. This will make up for the deficit from Southaven and also pay for dinner for the students. We will probably feed them around 6:00 p.m.

**Personal Accounts-** If you want money deducted from your student's personal accounts, you must tell Mrs. Lanie to take it out. She won't automatically deduct money for bus or camp fees. Also, if you send in a check, please write your students name on the memo line.

**Mass Band-** Will be held at the football game on October 30<sup>th</sup>.

**Band Expenses-** Director Dell Trotter gave a summary of the yearly band expenses.

**Spring Trip-** The band will be traveling to Disney in March during Spring Break. This is a fund trip only, the band will not be performing in any way. This will cost \$725 per student. The \$50 deposit is due by September 15<sup>th</sup>. Payments of \$225 are due on November 1<sup>st</sup>, January 1<sup>st</sup> and February 1<sup>st</sup>. We will be leaving March 29<sup>th</sup> and returning April 3<sup>rd</sup>. Please make checks payable to Harrison Central Band Boosters and include your students name on the memo line. Amenities include transportation on new luxury liners, quad rooms in the Marriott Village hotel, tickets to all attractions, 5 breakfasts, 4 lunches and 1 dinner show. One night is set aside as "grad night" at Universal. They reopen the park after hours and it's available to seniors only. The cost is \$60 extra if your student would like to go.

### Fundraisers-

**Coupon Books-** Money or books are due back immediately.

**Coke Sale-** Went well; we earned \$4.50 per case towards personal accounts. We will be starting another sale October 8<sup>th</sup> through October 21<sup>st</sup>. They will be here on October 31<sup>st</sup> to pick up. Cases are \$13 each.

**Sherwood Farms Greenery-** Get order forms and brochures from Stacey Barefoot. 30% of personal delivery items and 10% of direct delivery items goes to personal accounts.

**CiCi's Pizza-** Cici's has decided to stay open late after every home game and give us 10% of the total sales. Also, we'll get 10% of the sales every 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday if we let them know it's for the band. This will all go to general fund.

**Car Wash-A-Thon-** Rescheduled for October 31st, 8:30-4 at PTW. This will go to personal accounts. You must get at least two sponsors and sign up to work to get a share of the profits. The coke truck will also be there to sell cases, but this will go towards the general fund. The sno-cone man will be there too for a little while.

**Football Raffle-** We have a Green Bay football signed by Brett Favre with pen in an acrylic case to raffle. Tickets will be \$2 each. \$1 of each ticket will go to personal accounts. We will draw the winning ticket on November 12<sup>th</sup> at Field of Dreams.

**Individual Fundraisers-** If you want to do fundraising on your own, that's fine. Please don't go to Sams Club though because that's something we need to do as a group. If you go anywhere on your own you may put on your signs: Please support my child who is with the Harrison Central High School band, or some version of this. You may NOT put on your signs: Please support the Harrison Central High School band, or any version of this. If you do, you will have to split your profits with the ENTIRE band.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Annual "Field of Dreams"**- This will be the last marching performance for the year. Seniors will be recognized and lots of other fun activities and performances will take place. The concession will be open. We will also have a silent auction as well as raffles taking place. We invite vendors to set up for a percentage of the sales that night. Admission is \$5 each and a10 and under are free.
